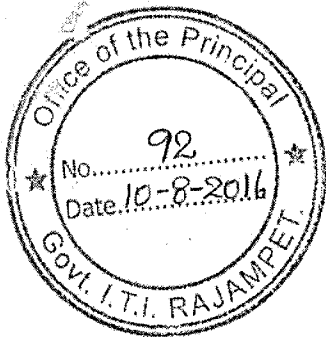

Subject: Revised norms for minimum attendance under Semester system of Craftsmen Training Scheme.

Sir/Madam

A Working Group was constituted comprising of Secretaries of the 04 States on the "Career Progression of ITI Instructors and changes in CTS programme". Three meetings of the Working Group were held. The Working Group also discussed norms for minimum attendance under Semester system of Craftsmen Training Scheme.

The recommendations of working group on norms for minimum attendance under Semester system of CTS were discussed vide agenda item No.9 in the meeting of Sub Committee of NCVT dealing with Norms & Courses held on 17.12.2015, at New Delhi.

After detailed discussion, the Sub-committee approved following revised norms for minimum attendance under Semester system of CTS.

- i. With less than 80% but upto 70% attendance in 1st Semester, the candidate can go to next semester but at the end of 2nd semester he has to secure 80% cumulative attendance.
- ii. At the end of the course he has to have 80% attendance to appear the final examination.
- iii. For emergency cases, concerned ITI Principal may be empowered to relax maximum 5%.
- iv. If attendance is below the prescribed limit, in a particular semester even after exercising all the options at (iii) above, then the candidate would be allowed to continue in the next semester but will appear in the examination of the previous semester subject to completion of 80% attendance in the earlier semester(s) taken together.

Directors of all the States and Union Territories Administrations are requested to follow above norms and issue further necessary instructions to all Principals of Government and Private ITIs with a request to follow the revised norms for minimum attendance under Semester system of CTS.

Sir/Madam,


This is to inform that 7th meeting of "Sub-committee of NCVT on Norms and Courses" was held on 26th May, 2017 in Main Committee Room, 1st Floor, 'C' Wing, Shram Shakti Bhawan, Rafi Marg, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Director General/ Joint Secretary, MSDE. Guidelines regarding fulfilling of minimum attendance criteria under Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) under semester pattern of examination was discussed as agenda item no. 8 in the above meeting.

After detailed discussion, the Sub-Committee approved that the trainees will be promoted in next semester only and only if the attendance in previous semester is minimum 80% and hall ticket shall be generated by the portal, only when the trainee has secured minimum 80% attendance. Only for medical emergency cases, concerned ITI Principal is empowered to relax 10% for each semester separately.

Above guidelines supersede the previous norms which were communicated vide letter no. MSDE-19/03(13)/2015-CD dated 7th January, 2016. Henceforth, the above guidelines will be applicable for minimum attendance for AITT under semester system of CTS.

Directors of all the States and Union Territories dealing with Craftsmen Training Scheme are requested to issue further necessary instructions to all the ITIs under their jurisdiction to follow the revised norms for minimum attendance under semester system of Craftsmen Training Scheme.

Subject: Clarification on norms for minimum attendance under semester system of Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS).

This is in continuation of letter no. MSDE-19/01/2017 – CD dated 05th July, 2017. In this regard it is clarified that the above order is applicable to trainees admitted from session August, 2017 onward. The trainees of earlier batched shall be allowed to follow the attendance norms of MSDE-19/03(13)/2015-CD dated 07th January, 2016. Accordingly all the trainees who are in 2nd, 3rd and 4th semester and has less than 80% attendance but promoted to under semester as per order no. MSDE-19/03(13)/2015-CD dated 07th January, 2016, may be allowed to continue the training programme in their ITIs.
