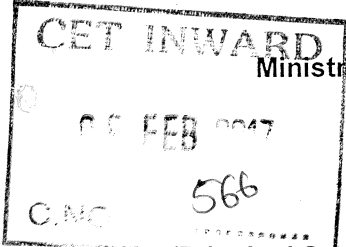

This is to inform that third meeting of reconstituted "Sub-committee of NCVT on Norms and Courses" was held on 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2016 in New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary, MSDE. "Norms for minimum compulsory training weeks for each semester and making it prerequisite for appearing All India Trade Test ( AITT) for Craftsmen " was discussed as agenda vide no. 10 in the above meeting.

The Sub-committee approved that the minimum 90 days of training for each semester shall be acquired by the trainee for appearing All India Trade Test (AITT) for Craftsmen.

Henceforth, the minimum 90 days of training for each semester shall be acquired by the trainee for appearing All India Trade Test (AITT) for Craftsmen. If any Government & Private ITI seeking affiliation for new trades and got the affiliation to run that trade have to ensure that the minimum 90 days training is completed by the trainee to enable him to for the AITT.

Directors of all the States and Union Territories dealing with Craftsmen Training Scheme are requested to issue further necessary instructions to all Principals of Government and Private ITIs to follow above norms. Hall tickets are issued to only these trainees who have completed minimum 90 days of training.
